

# Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics 2007 Harley Davidson Raffle

## Raffle Rules

1. Raffle tickets will not be sold to a person under the age of 18 years.
2. Ticket sellers will advise adult ticket buyers not to write the name of a person under 18 years of age on a ticket.
3. The draw will take place at 12:00 PM on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2007, at the RCMP Detachment located at 4811- 49 Street, Red Deer Alberta, T4N 1T8.
4. Agency representatives, Executive of Alberta Law Enforcement Torch and Executive members of Special Olympics Alberta, as well as members of their immediate family (a spouse, parent, son, daughter, brother, sister, or spouse of any of these individuals) are not eligible to receive raffle prizes.
5. The minimum number of tickets to be sold before requesting a draw date extension or canceling the raffle is 1,000 tickets.
6. There are three prizes, to be drawn in the following order:
  - Third Prize** – 56” DLP Projection Television; retail value of \$2644
  - Second Prize** – Choice of Vacation Package for Two to Mayan Riviera, Ixtapa, Punta Cana, or Varadero; retail value of \$5000
  - First Prize** -- 2007 Black Harley Davidson FLSTF Fat Boy Motorcycle, complete with Security System; retail value of \$23,745.
7. Prize winning tickets will not be returned into the draw to be eligible for remaining prizes.
8. All prizes must be accepted as presented – no substitutions or “cash in lieu” option for any prize.
9. The following restrictions also apply to prizes:
  - Vacation Package - Package includes Roundtrip airfare from Calgary and accommodations for two, inclusions as listed with tour operator, airport transfers at destination, all taxes and fees.
    - i. Based on double occupancy
    - ii. Valid until December 15, 2008
    - iii. Subject to availability
    - iv. Christmas and Spring Break Peak Seasons excluded
  - Motorcycle - Winner must arrange for pick up in Red Deer, Alberta.
10. Prizes to be held for one year’s time from draw date. All attempts will be made to contact the winner. However, if after that time the winner can not be immediately located, a request will be made to the Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission for the prize to be donated back to Special Olympics.
11. Those requesting a refund of their ticket price must contact the Special Olympics Alberta office, (780) 415-0719, on or before June 16, 2007.
12. In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the licensed charity shall award the prize to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The licensed charity and the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission are not responsible for any dispute which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
